Disability Assessment Schedule

Receptive language:

- a. Lacking
- b. Simple orders
- c. Practical tasks
- d. Personal experiences or needs

Expressive language:

- a. Lacking
- b. Simple words or gestures
- c. Words or gestures to express personal needs
- d. Words or gestures to express personal experiences
- e. Events that do not involve personal experiences

Social interaction

- a. Does not establish relations
- b. Seeks and responds only to physical contact
- c. Establishes relations only to satisfy personal needs
- d. Initiates social contact
- e. Maintains social contact with people she knows
- f. Maintains contact with other people
- g. Reacts normally to social contacts



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Immediate echolalia

- a. Insufficient language
- b. Rare or non-existent
- c. Frequent
- d. Daily

Delayed echolalia

- a. Insufficient language
- b. Rare or non-existent
- c. Frequent
- d. Daily

Complex stereotypical behaviour and routines

- a. Absent or rare
- b. Slight routines or obsessive behaviour
- c. Intense and maladaptive stereotypes
